Our State, Our County & Our Society

Long before there was Missouri or Pike County, Indians roamed this land. They made no settlement nor did any constructive work. They were numerous and peaceably disposed, but by nature easily roused. They were friendly with the first settlers, but the year 1813 was one of terror.

Many tribes of Indians lived in Missouri when white man first arrived. The Missouri Indians dwelt in what is now east-central Missouri. The Osage (unusually tall) Indians lived and hunted in areas to the south and west. Other tribes included the Fox and Sauk Indians who lived in the north. As the whites increased, Indians became less frequently seen, although as late as 1856 there were some seen coming into town.

In 1818 Missouri asked congress to be admitted into the Union. At this time it was part of the "Territory of Louisiana", which was organized by congress in 1805. The portions of Missouri settled at that time were divided into four districts: (St.Louis, St.Charles, Cape Girardeau, & St.Genevieve.) All territory north of St.Charles district was uninhabited.

In 1821 Missouri was admitted into the Union. Our first capital being in St.Charles (1821-1826), then Jefferson City since 1826.

For years many people outside Missouri knew only one county in the state-the county of Pike. Pike Co. is older than our state, born and christened at St.Louis 14 Dec.1818. Pike Co. was cut from St. Charles Co. and named after Zebulon Montgomery Pike, an early explorer. Two counties divide the honor of his name: PIKE & MONTGOMERY, both formed in 1818. Only seven counties came before.- St. Louis, Oct.01,1812- St.Charles, Oct.01,1812- Cape Girardeau,Oct 01,1812- St.Genevieve, Oct.01,1812- New Madrid, Oct.01,1812- Washington, Aug. 21,1813- & Howard, Jan.23,1816.


The history of our county seat begins with that of the county itself. The same act of the legislature that established the county also appointed

commissioners to locate the seat of justice. Their report was submitted in April of 1820, to the circuit court then in session in Louisiana, which had been selected for the public buildings. On Dec. 14, 1822 the General Assembly appointed three commissioners to superintend the building of the court-house and jail at the new county seat, which proved to be Bowling Green. Bowling Green was named by early settlers who came from Bowling Green,Ky. The two towns are laid out alike.

The first court house was erected in 1823. Nathaniel Montgomery contracted to build the court house for \$75. First session in the new building was in Nov.1823. By 1827 the mud plaster was falling, the roof leaked, and it was becoming too small for its purpose.

The second court house was made of brick, this house was built by John & Walter Crow in 1828.. It was used until 1844 when it also became too small for its needs

The Co. court appropriated \$6,000 for a THIRD court house, erected in 1844 by W.W. Blain and Samuel Kem. It was a brick structure & faced the south. This house burned on the night of 18 Mar. 1864.

The FOURTH court house was built in 1868 by Conrad Smith at a cost of \$80,000, it burned 16 Oct. 1915. The present court house was constructed in 1917 at a cost of \$125,000.

Our court house is open daily 9:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. daily, & 9:00 to noon on Sat. (except holidays)

We have marriage records from 1816; deeds start at 1820; circuit court records start 1819; probate records starting 1825; one book on births 1883-1884.

After 1910 all birth and death records are on file in Jefferson City. Before 1910 all records were in each county, most of our early births and deaths were destroyed in the fires in 1864 and 1915.
